PROGRAMMES OF STUDY

- (i) There shall be following types of Under-Graduate Programmes-
- 4-Year UG Degree (Honours / Honours with Research)
 - 3-Year UG Degree
 - As per the Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes, developed by the UGC there will be provisions for awarding **UG Certificate** and **UG Diploma**. Separate Rules/Guidelines will be framed in this regard.
 - For 4 year UG Degree (Honours with Research), a student can choose a research stream in fourth year subject to fulfilment of all conditions; laid down by the UGC for implementation of NEP and Curriculum Credit Frame Work.
- (ii) A candidate shall be allowed to pursue any one of the Programmes in a particular Academic Session. At the initial stage, every student has to choose one Major subject and two Minor subjects
- (iii) Students admitted either in any Programmes of Studies shall have to study Discipline Core (DC) Courses, Generic Electives (GE) Courses, Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Courses, Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC), Ability Enhancement Compulsory (AEC) Courses, Value addition Courses (VAC), Apprenticeship / Project / Community Outreach Courses.
- (iv) A student have to identify the different subjects/disciplines he / she will have to undertake as per respective Course Structure to attain the required credits throughout the whole period of eight/six (08/06) semesters of the programme.
- (v) Programme, once chosen by the student, cannot be changed without approval of the appropriate authority of the University.
- (vi) All the Undergraduate students of the University have to register themselves for Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) through <http://www.abc.gov.in/> .

Rules regarding admission

1) Minimum Eligibility Criteria :

- (i) **4-Year UG Degree (Honours / Honours with Research):** A student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent Examination from other Boards / Councils with at least four subjects having English as Compulsory Subject of 100 marks is eligible to take admission to the Honours Programmes of Studies of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./B.C.A. on the basis of merit and available vacancy of the particular subject(s) in the college.
- (ii) **3-Year UG Degree:** A student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent Examination from other Boards/Councils with at least four subjects having English as Compulsory Subject of 100 marks is eligible to take admission to the General Programmes of Studies of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. on the basis of merit and available vacancy of the particular subject(s) in the college.
- (iii) A student who has passed Higher Secondary (10+2) examinations (with English as a subject) of the West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education and Skill Development or any equivalent Courses from National or State Level Board in regular mode shall be eligible to take admission to the 3-Year UG Degree Programme only.
- (iv) **NRI:** In case of any NRI applicant, the applicant should inform the College Authority before admission.
- (v) **Students who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examinations in the current year, immediate previous year and the year before the previous year will only be allowed to take admission.**
- (vi) Aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks in top-four subjects, including Marks obtained in English, in order of marks secured by a candidate. Marks obtained in Compulsory Environmental Studies (if any) shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks.

2) **Reservation of seats : Govt. rules will be followed.**

3) **Merit Point Calculation :**

The selection criteria and merit will be prepared as per the provisions of the University. The Merit Point Calculation will be done as follows:

a) Subject to the eligibility criteria, the merit lists for the 4-Year UG Degree (Honours / Honours with Research) Courses will be prepared as:

i) $(S+T)/4$

[Where S = Subject marks (opted for Honours Course) and T = Marks obtained in English + best marks of two other subjects].

ii) In case, any candidate opts for an Honours Course beyond his/her subject combination [except linguistic subjects at H.S. (10+2) level], the merit point will be calculated as: $T_1/4$.

[Where T_1 = Marks obtained in English + best marks of three other subjects (excluding English)].

b) Subject to the eligibility criteria, the merit lists for the 3-Year UG Degree Course will be prepared as:

$T_1/4$

[Where T_1 = Marks obtained in English + best marks of three other subjects (excluding English)].

4) **Admission will be made from Merit List through e-counselling.**

5) **After admission, all original documents should be verified at college premises within 7 (seven) days from the date of commencement of the class.**

The documents needed are –

- a) **Marksheet of H. S. or equivalent examination**
- b) **Caste Certificate (if any)**
- c) **Physically handicapped / challenged Certificate (if any)**
- d) **School Leaving Certificate**
- e) **Residential Certificate (Voter ID, Ration Card or Adhar Card)**
- f) **Passport Size Photo 1 copy.**

If there is any discrepancy between the supplied information in the application form and the original documents, the admission will be cancelled and the candidate will be responsible for that.

Procedure for filling-up the forms

- 1) Firstly open our website www.kaliyaganjcollege.ac.in and click 'onlineadmission into 1st Semester, 2023-2024' button or open 'www.onlineadmissionkaliyaganjcollege.org.in'. Then obtain the detailed informations by clicking 'Application Procedure' button. [If the page 'Notice Board – Online Application will be started soon' come, then click 'ctrl + f5' to clear the page and then proceed]
- 2) Click 'Apply online'. Two options will come — '[Apply for a 4-Year UG Degree \(Honours / Honours with Research\)](#)' & '[Apply for a 3-Year UG Degree](#)'. Click the desired button and the application form will be opened.
- 3) Fill-up the form properly. Browse your photo and other documents from any source (internal or external) and paste it in proper place. Be careful about your date of birth. After submitting the form, you can edit your form except date of birth.
- 4) After completion of form fill-up, 'Submit' button will come. Click 'submit' button and the filled-up form will be seen. After checking (you can go back for correction if any), confirm it. Then two buttons will come — '**Print Form**' & '**Exit**'. Click '**Print Form**' to get hard-copy of your application. If you click '**EXIT**' then you will be left from the application.
- 5) You will find your 'Application ID' at the top of your submitted Application form. This 'Application ID, will be your user ID and your date of birth will be your password for the later operations.
- 6) You will get the options for 'Duplicate Application Form & 'Form Correction' at Home Page.
- 7) Follow the Programme at web-site.
- 8) A candidate can apply for 4-Year UG Degree (Honours/Honours with Research) Programme in maximum 3 (three) subjects in a single application form.
- 9) Initially, the admission will be provisional. Later on, it will be confirmed if everything is OK.
- 10) The process of 'form fill-up' & 'admission' may be cancelled or postponed at any stage due to special reasons.
